## VIPP 2022 BY THE NUMBERS

VIPP programming truly spanned the globe in 2022 with **315** international participants from **58** countries and **five** continents, and programming in more than **10** different U.S. cities.

VIPP secured a total of **\$2.6 million** in grants, and the estimated economic impact to the local area was about **\$2 million**.

VIPP engaged with more than **100** MSU faculty members and other professionals across Michigan and the U.S. for programming in a variety of thematic areas including civic engagement and rule of law, communication, education, entrepreneurship and innovation, food nutrition and biotechnology, and leadership.
