# Sichuan Media Administration Workshop

February 16 – 18, 2004

A group of eight administrators from various television, radio, and newspaper companies located in Sichuan Province spent several days learning more about the American media industry. They attended seminars and in-house meetings at WKAR, WABC 53, and the Lansing State Journal. They asked many questions about technology and reporting techniques. Members of the American media also had many questions about the same topics for the delegation from China.

## Guangdong Land Resource Management Workshop

February 17 – 20, 2004

A group of eight land resource management specialists attended lectures provided by Professor Jiaguo Qi at MSU's Department of Geography and Mr. Jim Goodheart from the Michigan

Department of Environmental Quality. They discussed land use issues facing the state of Michigan and provided details on how science and policy are influencing the future of Michigan's land use. The lectures also focused on how politics shapes the landscape of land use.

## **Grain Inspection Administration Workshop**

February 19 – 26, 2004

This group of 16 administrative grain inspectors met with MSU Plant and Soil Science Professor Larry Copeland and Michigan Department of Agriculture Inspection Coordinator Byron Beerbower. They discussed various topics including, genetic modification, technology analysis, grain disease identification, grain storage, and other aspects of grain inspection.

#### Rep. Hopgood Addresses the Issues

February 24, 2004

Michigan House Representative Hoon-Yung Hopgood provided some insight on what it is like to run a campaign and try to understand how and why people might vote for a particular candidate. He also fielded some difficult questions from the VIPP audience, on topics such as gay marriage, recycling, civil rights, hunting, and weighing his beliefs versus the beliefs of his constituency. He also explained Michigan's current laws enforcing term limits and how this is affecting the ability of members of the State House and Senate to govern. He believes that there will be an attempt to lengthen the time of term limits.
