Tuition: \$12,060 including all courses, east coast trip (excluding flight back to MSU), double certification*, Lansing airport pick up, VIPP cultural & social events, orientation and graduation ceremony. Fee does not include health insurance (\$1,013 for 6-months), housing in Spartan Village (\$540-\$1,080 per month, plus a \$40 housing application fee), airfare and any additional living expenses. Admission Requirements:

- Sophomore or junior at a 4-year college
- Majors in food science or any related field
- Good academic standing
- TOEFL IBT 79 with no subscore below 17, paper-based 550 with no subscore below 52, or IELTS 6.5.
- Application fee of \$150 dollars (non-refundable)

***Double Certification:** (1) Certification through the Summer School Modern Packaging program and (2) GYPP certification on Food Science
