Dr. Gill-Chin Lim, former Dean of International Studies and Programs (1991-1995) was a leader, a friend and a teacher. "We were all saddened by his sudden death," said Sandy Holy, Assistant Director of VIPP. During his many years at Michigan State University, Dr. Lim was an Endowed Professor of Asian Studies in a Global Context, a professor of Urban and Regional Planning, and Director of the Program on Humanistic Globalization. He provided academic

leadership for international events at Michigan State as well as oversaw the reconstruction of the International Studies Program (ISP). Throughout his time here, he created VIPP, established the ISP International Awards Ceremony, and developed the

Glen Taggart Award for Community Contribution and the Ralph Smuckler Award for Advancing International Studies and Programs. "He was a powerhouse of a person who left us with a blueprint that will enable us to continue his vision," Holy said.
